



CHOICE OF THE PARCEL

The walnut tree is cultivated in very different grounds, however the choice of the ground will be one determining factor in the success of your orchard.

- Avoid parcels exposed to freezing.
- Physicochemical analyses of the ground and subsoil and a farming profile will guide you in this choice and will allow you to bring the suitable fertilization, and carry out, if necessary subsoiling, drainage (this subsoiling would be realized in dry ground).
- If possible plant on a cultivation precedent such as cereals or green manure; it let you time for a good ground work.
- Avoid the plantations on asphyxiating grounds.

SELECTION OF GOOD QUALITY SEEDLINGS

Plant INRA CTIFL labelled seedlings 2 years old from seedbed if there is irrigation, 1 year old if not.
